How Do I Log into GCIS Junior?

1. Log onto the computer.
2. Go to www.gcic.peachnet.edu or click the GCIS Junior icon on your desktop.
3. Click on the second icon on the left side of the pages that says **Click Here to Enter Georgia Career Information System GCIS Junior**.

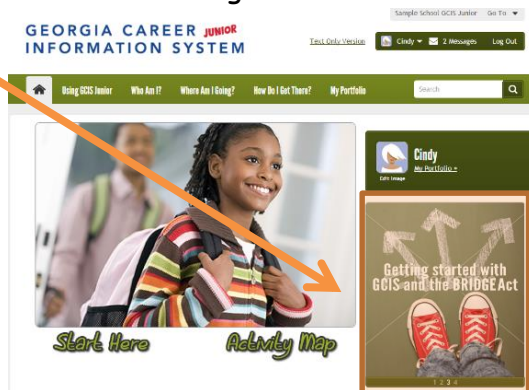


4. On the next screen, enter your "My Portfolio" username and password. Click **Sign In**.

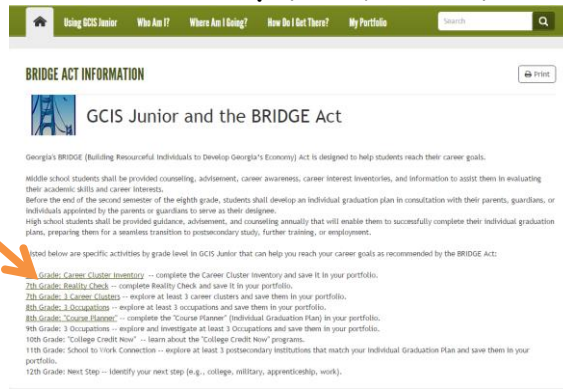


How Do I Get Started with My Activity?

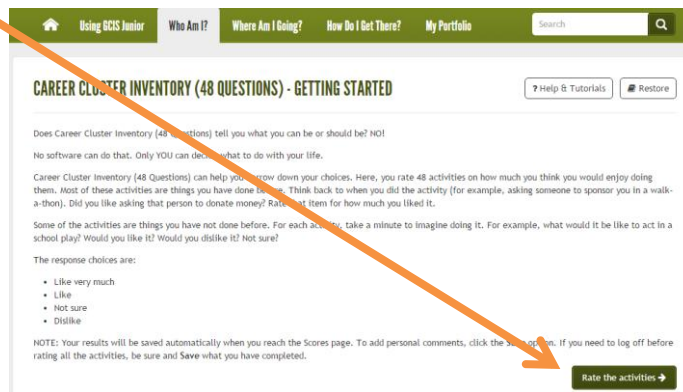
5. On the right side of the screen, click on the rotating pictures to display **Getting Started with GCIS and the BRIDGE Law**. Click the image.



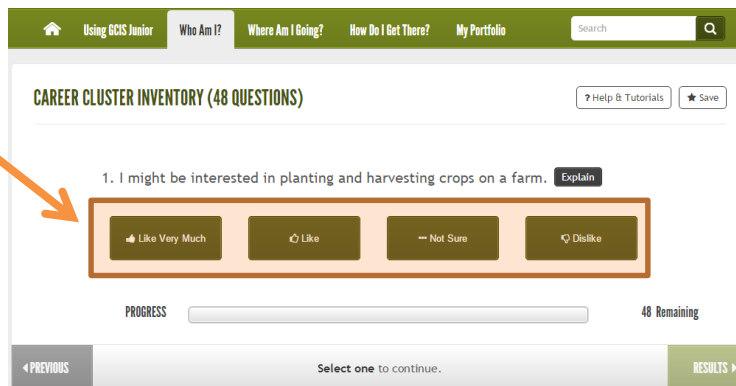
6. Click **6th Grade: Career Cluster Inventory (48 Questions)**.



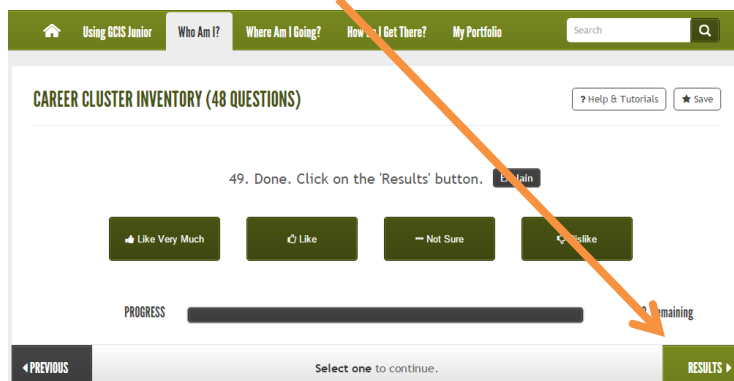
7. Read the instructions and click the **Rate the Activities** button



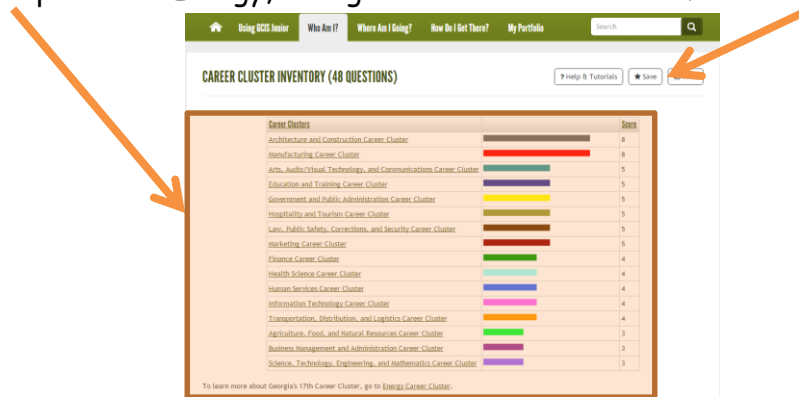
